The Sandwich Fire Dept normally has their annual open house the Sunday after fire prevention week. This year we are moving our open house and celebrating events to coincide with the City of Sandwich's events. The Sandwich Fire Dept will be celebrating our 125th anniversary Saturday September 26th and Sunday September 27th.

On Saturday September 26th we will be joining the City of Sandwich's parade at 10:00am with antique fire apparatus from all around. During the Citizen's Bucket Brigade there will be a static Antique Fire Truck Display where there is a prize for Best in Show Antique Fire Truck.

On Sunday the Sandwich Cub Scout Troop will be hosting a Pancake Breakfast from 7:30am till 12:00 at the Fire Station. During the Pancake Breakfast at 10:00am the Sandwich Fire Department will have a Open house till 2:00pm. The open house activities will consist of:

  - Car Extrication Demonstration
